

A2 Certificate Of Competence (A2 CofC) (Part-Time)

This qualification allows you to legally fly your drone in more demanding locations (such as built-up areas) and to fly closer to uninvolved people. Holding an A2 CofC means that you can operate in the new A2 (Open) subcategory, no matter if it's for recreational or commercial reasons.

Entry Requirements

In preparation for the A2 CofC Theory Course you must adhere to the CAA drone and model aircraft code and obtain a Flyer ID from the CAA.

Career Prospects

Successful delegates can progress onto the General Visual Line of Sight Certificate (GVC) course.


