The AS Level / A Level French is a Full-time Further Education course located in the Sixth Form Academy (SFA). This is designed to develop your French language skills. You will develop confident, effective communication skills in French and a thorough understanding of the culture of countries and communities where French is spoken.

The course will nurture an interest in, and enthusiasm for, language learning and encourages students to consider their study of the language in a broader context. The themes covered are, being a young person in a French speaking society and understanding the French-speaking world, diversity and difference and France from 1940 - 1950.
