



GCSE English Language (Part-Time: Online Delivery) January Start

A fast-track GCSE English Language class with examinations in May/June 2025. Delivery will be online and approximately 3 hours per week. The course will prepare you for both the written and oral elements of assessment on the course. This intensive course will also require students to undertake at least 3 hours self-study per week to ensure suitable progress in time for the summer examinations.

The first class will take place on Wednesday 15 January 2025.

Career Prospects

A majority of professions require a C in GCSE English as a minimal entry requirement. To begin a PGCE you require a B in GCSE English.

Assessment

The English language (Wales) GCSE is made up of two equally weighted externally assessed units, and one internally assessed unit. The two externally assessed units test Reading and Writing skills, whilst the internally assessed unit tests Oracy skills. This specification is untiered.

Method of Assessment - Assessment is by two 2 hour examinations and an internally assessed and externally moderated Oracy module.
