



## Level 2 Certificate in Cabin Crew (Full-Time)

This course is designed for students who would like to enter the air industry, and is also an excellent route into many other tourism sector roles. It provides theoretical and practical experience, which will be assessed in a working environment. Students will also undertake a compulsory visit to an airport, where they will complete Cabin Crew training within a real environment. This is a wonderful opportunity to obtain professional development and assessment.

### Entry Requirements

6 GCSE's at grade C or above or equivalent, to include Maths or English. No previous business studies experience is needed.

### Career Prospects

The recognised progression route is onto HE courses or employment. Graduates have the prospect of entering an extremely diverse choice of career paths after completion of this course, and this is one of the extremely appealing factors to consider when making a choice for FE study.
